



InGenesis, Alamo Travel Group among fastest growing inner-city firms

Two San Antonio companies have been ranked among the fastest growing inner city companies in the U.S. by Fortune magazine and the Initiative for a Competitive Inner City (ICIC).

InGenesis, a staffing and management consulting company founded in 1998, ranked No. 4 on the list while the Alamo Travel Group ranked No. 97. The companies are being recognized as role models for entrepreneurship, innovative business practices and job creation in America's urban communities.

"These entrepreneurs are driving economic forces in America's urban cores, growing their communities along with their businesses," says Mary Kay Leonard, ICIC president and CEO.

The 2013 Inner City 100 winners grew at a compound annual growth rate of 36 percent and an average standard growth rate of 411 percent between 2007 and 2011. Collectively, the top 100 inner city businesses employ 10,391 people and have created more than 5,863 new jobs between 2007 and 2011.
