

S.A.'s InGenesis ranks as 126th fastest growing

InGenesis Inc. has been ranked No. 126 on the Inc. 500 list of the fastest-growing companies in the U.S.

The company's 2,176.5-percent increase in revenue from 2007-2010 secured its spot in the 500 list for the first time.

The San Antonio-based firm, which provides its clients in the healthcare and scientific industries with a range of staffing, consulting and research services, ranked 684 last year and has made the overall Inc. 5000 list for the past four years.

"Making the Inc. 500 list for the first time shows just how far we've come in such a tough economy," said Veronica Edwards, president and CEO of InGenesis.

An analysis of Inc. 500 data also reveals that InGenesis is the fastest growing medical staffing firm in the healthcare category and its president is also one of the top 10 women CEOs of the fastest growing companies on the list.

The Inc. 500 honor comes on the heels of InGenesis' No.1 ranking in Hispanic Business magazine's list of "Top 10 Companies by Year-To-Year Percent Revenue Growth."

Hispanic Business also ranked InGenesis at 97 in its list of 500 largest Hispanic-owned businesses in the U.S.

Edwards' business success has brought her recognition from the United States Hispanic Chamber of Commerce as one of the top 10 Latina CEOs in the country.

She and nine other Latina CEOs will be recognized on Sept. 20 at the Miami Beach Convention Center in Miami.

The San Antonio Business Journal recently awarded Edwards with a Women's Leadership Award in the Business Growth category and the No.1 spot in its Fast Track Awards.
