



## **Local Entrepreneur among Leaders of Fastest-Growing Women-Owned Companies**

**San Antonio** (May 4, 2015) --- San Antonio-based entrepreneur Veronica Edwards has been recognized as the leader behind one of the fastest-growing firms in the US.

Edwards, who is the president and CEO of InGenesis, was one of eight women-business owners from Texas to be named to the 50 Fastest-Growing Women-Owned/Led Companies — an annual report by the Women Presidents' Organization (WPO), in partnership with American Express Global Corporate Payments.

Medical staffing provider InGenesis held the No. 31 spot on the list — which was compiled according to a firm's sales growth from 2010 to 2014. Over that period of time, InGenesis's reported revenues grew from \$51 million to nearly \$118 million. InGenesis also reported that over the four-year period, it had added more than 1,500 jobs.

The WPO/American Express report marks the latest accolade for InGenesis — which has made several of the Business Journal's recent Top 25 lists. This past September, for example, InGenesis took the No. 3 spot on the Top Women-owned firms list with a local staff of 317; and the No. 3 spot on the Top Minority-owned firms list, with local revenues of \$111.7 million for 2013. This past November, InGenesis took the No. 2 spot on the Business Journal's list of Top Permanent Placement Agencies, having reported 138 direct hires in 2013.
