One of city's largest woman-owned staffing firms adds new satellite branches

SAN ANTONIO (January 20, 2016) -- InGenesis Inc., a San Antonio-based staffing and workforce solutions firm, has added 38 new satellite branch locations throughout the United States, according to news wire reports.

The infrastructure expansion is designed to foster new business relationships and continue the woman-owned firm's growth trajectory as demand for contingent labor is expected to rise in 2016.

"Over the past year our management team worked very discreetly to strategically expand our portfolio of support offices which now includes 52 branches tasked to support our growing client portfolio," said Veronica Muzquiz Edwards, president & CEO. The location of the new branches was not disclosed.

"Based on the strength of our management team, business model and back office systems, InGenesis is poised for global expansion," said Edwards.

Last year, InGenesis achieved a number of milestones. Staffing Industry Analysts recognized InGenesis as one of the largest staffing firms in North America. Among diversity-owned staffing firms, InGenesis ranked as the largest workforce solutions company wholly owned by a woman. Inc. magazine also recognized InGenesis as one of the fastest-growing privately owned companies in the United States for the eighth straight year.
